

ELECTION REFORM PROPOSALS

ISSUE	PROPOSAL
End Partisan Gerrymandering	Advocate for the establishment of non-partisan redistricting commissions like those used in California and Arizona and proposed in numerous ballot measures in other states in 2018.
Repeal Sore Loser Laws	Repeal sore loser laws as they are antithetical to the American democratic process and serve only to limit voter choice, protect the privileged position of two major parties and squash political competition.
Expand Voting Rights	Eliminate all unnecessary barriers to the right to vote so that any and all eligible Americans can easily and inexpensively register to vote and cast their vote. Disenfranchisement of any kind is un-American.
Reform Campaign Finance Disclosure	Shine a bright light on all “dark money” political expenditures and require that the source of all election related expenditures be clearly and immediately disclosed to the public
Expand Ballot Access	Increase voter choice, encourage new candidates to run for office and foster competition by removing the artificial barriers to ballot access that the two major parties use to protect their privileged position
Implement Non-Partisan Primaries	Advocate for non-partisan primary elections such as those in California and Washington State so that all voters, regardless of party affiliation, have an equal voice in choosing the candidates who will appear on the General Election ballot
