



ELECTION REFORM PROPOSALS

ISSUE	PROPOSAL
End Partisan Gerrymandering	Establish non-partisan commissions in which the power to draw districts is taken out of the hands of self-interested politicians and returned to the citizens.
Repeal Sore Loser Laws	Repeal sore loser laws as they are antithetical to the American democratic process and serve only to limit voter choice, protect the privileged position of two major parties, and squash political competition.
Reform Campaign Finance Disclosure	Shine a bright light on all “dark money” political expenditures and require that the source of all election related expenditures be clearly and immediately disclosed to the public.
Give Voters More Election Choices	Advocate for “top four” non-partisan primary elections and for Ranked Choice Voting in General Elections so that all voters, regardless of party affiliation, have an equal and greater voice in primaries and in General Elections.
Expand Voter Registration and Voter Access	Eliminate all unnecessary barriers to the right to vote so that any and all eligible Americans can easily and inexpensively register to vote and cast their vote. Disenfranchisement of any kind is un-American.
Improve Ballot Access	Increase voter choice, encourage new candidates to run for office, and foster competition by removing the barriers to ballot access that the two major parties use to protect their privileged position.
